Semitic.


Traditional & low-income farmers.

UN Convention,

genocide definition

(Article II)

Any of the following acts committed with intent to destroy, in whole or in part, a national, <u>ethnical</u>, <u>racial or religious group</u>, as such:

- a) Killing members of the group
- b) Causing serious bodily or mental harm to members of the group
- c) Deliberately inflicting on the group conditions of life calculated to bring about its physical destruction in whole or in part
- d) Imposing measures intended to prevent births within the group
- e) Forcibly transferring children of the group to another group.

Ethnic federalist policy & genocidal violence

- Regions constructed along ethnic lines.
- Physical & in-group/out-group ethnic boundaries activated within non-homogenous regions.
- Land annexations & disputes.
- Anti-Amhara rhetoric.





Genocidal violence against ethnic Amhara

- Ethnically targeted killings of Amhara.
- Massacres for 3+ decades.
- Ongoing war & drone strikes on civilians in the Amhara region.

Genocidal destruction of the Amhara population

- Ethnic cleansing & forced displacement of millions.
 - Genocidal rape & enforced lacerations of pregnant women to prevent birth.
- Torture, arbitrary arrest & enforced disappearance.

Transitioned from administrative province to Ethnic map (1995)
