- Active genocide of Amharas in Ethiopia (East Africa)
- O Victims are mostly farmers, elderlies, women, and children
- Currently, little to no media coverage or intervention

- Vanished over
 2.4 million
- Displaced over 1 million

- 4. Others




On mid-April 2021 alone, Ataye town fully destroyed with 3 consecutive attacks

- Rapping of young children and elderlies
- Induced infertility without consent
- Massacre of Amhara religious leaders
- Multiple villages & towns burned down to ash
- 17 university girls, 4 boys & many more young boys kidnapped
- 46 kidnapped (nurses and farmers)
- Many farmers are being hunted down in Wollega & Metekel. They are hiding in forests- need immediate rescuing
- Systemic high infant mortality

Destroyed in Ataye & areas

- 3,073 total (in Ataye alone 1529) houses destroyed
- 246,818 displaced and starving- 9,661 of them are in critical need
- 4,416 acre harvest & food storages destroyed

More destroys in Ataye

- 23,000 people no access to water
- All public services destroyed
 - 4 schools, 3 hospitals, courts...
 - 7 house of worships
 - 11 hotels & 350 additional businesses
 - 43 food processing mills
 - 61 farmers water pumps
 - >582 farm cattle vandalized
